## PEACE

The greeting of peace at Mass adds substance to a message of today's readings: peace is relational. When we greet in peace the person near us at Mass, we share the touch of a handshake or embrace, sincere eye contact, and friendly words.

The scriptures speak of a similar peace. The first reading from Isaiah describes the peace of the holy city, Jerusalem, a place of prosperity and comfort where the “LORD's power shall be known to his servants” (Isaiah 66:14c).

The Christian understanding of peace changes slightly. Paul writes of the “peace and mercy” on all who are created anew. Jesus describes a feeling of peace that will rest on those who accept his disciples and their message.

Peace is both an absence of strife and a personal blessing. May we always and sincerely bring peace to our own lives as we share it with others.



### *A Message from our Principal, Sister Cheryl Ann Hillig, DC:*

The Diocese of Savannah receives accreditation for the Catholic schools in this Diocese from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS). This accreditation is in its renewal year with all elementary and high schools that are Diocesan schools participating in the re-accreditation process. SPCCS hosted the “visiting team” who were impressed with our school and students. They gave an oral report at the conclusion of their visit to the entire Diocese. As a Diocese, our schools out-performed three of the four domains evaluated by SACS by a significant margin; only slightly missing the fourth domain of Technology and Resources. Since we are a *Mission Diocese*, additional financial resources must become available for this fourth domain in order to bring all our Diocesan schools up to the national average. This is a priority of Bishop Gregory J. Hartmayer, OFM, Michelle Kroll, Superintendent and Carrie Jane Williamson, Associate Superintendent.

In addition, SPCCS went through our three year FCC accreditation review in February. It was determined that we are on target with all Action Plan Goals through 2018 when re-accreditation is due.

### *News from the SPCCS Advancement Office:*

We humbly extend our sincere gratitude to every parishioner who helped the school exceed this year’s \$65,000 *“Gifts That Change Lives”* Annual Campaign goal. Your donations ensured that we met many of our school’s greatest needs; including implementation of the *“First In Math”* program. By the way, Ms. Milam, our Second Grade teacher, is ranked the #1 *First In Math* Teacher in Georgia!

**14º domingo de Tiempo Ordinario**  
*La alegría de la Buena Nueva*  
**Las lecturas y su mensaje**

**Isaías 66:10-14C**

La colección de poemas de los capítulos de Isaías recoge imágenes en las que se sugiere que reinaba cierta confusión en la vida religiosa del pueblo de Palestina de aquel tiempo. Se ofrece además la imagen de que los gentiles compartirán las riquezas de Israel después del juicio; y una advertencia de que los siervos del Señor se separarán de los enemigos por medio de un juicio apocalíptico. La nueva Jerusalén que se anuncia es una ciudad de paz, en contraste con la antigua Jerusalén donde reinaba la corrupción y la injusticia.

**Gálatas 6:14-18**

Pablo ha tenido una fuerte polémica con los gálatas a costa del argumento contra la circuncisión de la comunidad de origen no judío. Pablo deplora la actitud de rivalidad de los gálatas, pero al inal los llama hermanos, como signo de una cierta esperanza de lograr la reconciliación con ellos y su deseo de que se centren en la fidelidad al evangelio de Cristo más que en las leyes que no dan vida ni espíritu.

**Lucas 10:1-12, 17-20**

Solamente el evangelio de Lucas contiene dos episodios de envío a la misión. Al incluir 72, en lugar de los 12 discípulos más cercanos de Jesús, parece referirse a la universalidad del mensaje. La tradición judía aseguraba que el mundo estaba dividido en 70 naciones; por lo tanto, hay aquí una clara alusión a la universalidad tanto del mensaje como de la vocación al anuncio.

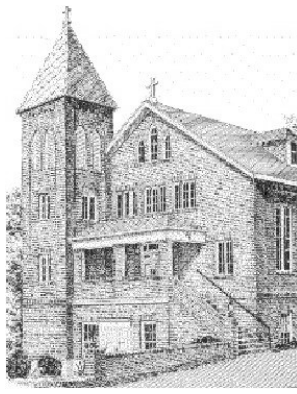
