### *A Message from our Principal, Sister Cheryl Ann Hillig, DC:*

The Diocese of Savannah receives accreditation for the Catholic schools in this Diocese from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS). This accreditation is in its renewal year with all elementary and high schools that are Diocesan schools participating in the re-accreditation process. SPCCS hosted the “visiting team” who were impressed with our school and students. They gave an oral report at the conclusion of their visit to the entire Diocese. As a Diocese, our schools out-performed three of the four domains evaluated by SACS by a significant margin; only slightly missing the fourth domain of Technology and Resources. Since we are a *Mission Diocese*, additional financial resources must become available for this fourth domain in order to bring all our Diocesan schools up to the national average. This is a priority of Bishop Gregory J. Hartmayer, OFM, Michelle Kroll, Superintendent and Carrie Jane Williamson, Associate Superintendent.

In addition, SPCCS went through our three year FCC accreditation review in February. It was determined that we are on target with all Action Plan Goals through 2018 when re-accreditation is due.

### *News from the SPCCS Advancement Office:*

We humbly extend our sincere gratitude to every parishioner who helped the school exceed this year’s \$65,000 *“Gifts That Change Lives”* Annual Campaign goal. Your donations ensured that we met many of our school’s greatest needs; including implementation of the *“First In Math”* program. By the way, Ms. Milam, our Second Grade teacher, is ranked the #1 *First In Math* Teacher in Georgia!

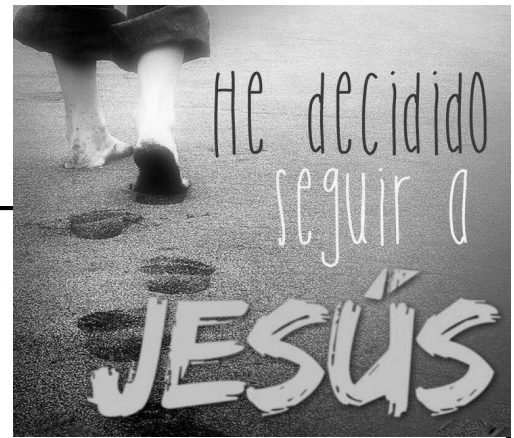

## Reflexiones sobre las Lecturas

Hoy día se habla mucho de identidad personal, de conocerse y saber bien quién es uno. Es lógico, porque con la rapidez con que ocurren las cosas, las mezclas de culturas, el desafío de los medios de comunicación que homologa las edades de los consumidores de medios, la rapidez con que se propagan ideas, parece que uno ya no sabe qué pensar.

En la Iglesia se habla también, con preocupación, de lo que esto implica para la fe. Si hay tanto donde elegir, si hay tantas corrientes y si a veces parece que todo es relativo a la situación de la propia persona o a su interpretación, los valores y las creencias y el credo se van diluyendo poco a poco, y comienza a reinar la confusión.

¿Quién no se pregunta a veces si no endrán razón los personajes de películas y series que hoy se casan y mañana se descasan por conveniencia, los que persiguen sus propios intereses por encima inclusive de los derechos de los demás, las que deciden que al fin y al cabo son dueñas de sus cuerpos y pueden abortar? Una de las cuestiones más importantes y urgentes de nuestro tiempo es encontrar nuestra identidad como cristianos; y eso, solo podemos encontrarlo respondiendo a la pregunta que hace Jesús hoy: "¿Quién dice la gente que soy yo?".

Los poetas dicen que a una persona muy enamorada le gustaría incluso desaparecer y disolverse en el ser amado. Quien quiera guardar su vida... es que parece ser, según Jesús, que quien quiere guardar su vida por encima de todo no es capaz de amar a otros y, por lo tanto, no es capaz de dar respuesta a la pregunta, ¿quién soy? No puede contestarse a sí mismo, porque no se puede encontrar; ha perdido su vida, su identidad.

La paradoja es que, al no importar que la propia vida se derrame hacia la persona amada, se afirma la propia identidad. Al responder a la pregunta de Jesús de quién es él, el enviado, el hijo amado de Dios, el salvador, podemos encontrar quiénes somos nosotros. También salvados por Cristo, somos hijos amados de Dios. No todo lo que nos dicen los medios de comunicación ni las corrientes psicológicas o filosóficas nos sirve; nos sirve la verdad de nuestra entrega y seguimiento al único Señor, Jesucristo.

### **Para la reflexión:**

**¿Me pregunto a veces quién soy?**

**¿Me siento a veces confuso en lo que se refiere a cuestiones de moral o de fe?**

## Nuestra cultura

La mayoría de las personas prefieren la compañía de gente de su propio grupo cultural, con el que comparten historia, manera de hacer las cosas, celebraciones, costumbres y lengua. Es muy enriquecedor, sin embargo, abrirse a otros grupos y a otras culturas y, sin perder la propia identidad, aprender la riqueza de otras expresiones. Es también un enorme desafío, porque a veces existen temores al rechazo o hay una experiencia previa de discriminación; es importante poder superar eso: nos hará más ricos humana y culturalmente, podremos aprender unos de otros, y, sobre todo, nos hará más católicos, más universales.

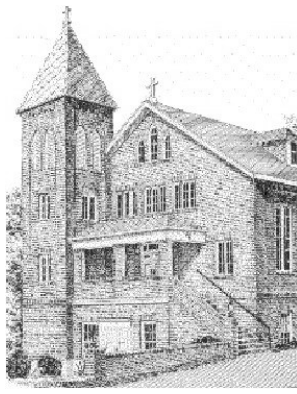
