Yearlong Campaign to Replace Church and Convent Roofs

An inspection over a year ago, recommended that the convent and church roofs be replaced as soon as possible. They were both deemed in poor condition. While no exact date was given, it seems that the roofs would need to be replaced before the summer of 2018. In consultation with the Diocesan Construction and Properties Office, bids were requested. Depending upon which bids are selected the cost for both buildings is between \$70,000 and \$110,000. The church roof is less difficult but the convent roof is slate and more complicated.

I waited until we made our BAA target before making this request. It is my plan to rename the "Capital Improvement Collection" to "New Church and Convent Roofs" (first Sunday monthly). In fact, if you use stewardship envelopes you will notice this change in your July-August envelopes. My plan is to dedicate this collection to partially cover the costs of these two urgently needed roofs. It is my desire that within a year or so we will raise half the total cost, so that the parish can minimize new debt to the diocese. Presently, we are on track to pay off our school preschool building (2003) debt within three years. That balance is just under \$70,000 and we pay \$1,700 principal and \$300 interest to the Diocese each month. Thanks to your generosity the parish now has a three month emergency fund in our savings. As late as the fall of 2015 we had no cushion! I am hesitant to deplete our emergency fund to pay for the roofs. Whatever we can raise by God's grace and your generosity will determine how much money we will need to borrow from the Diocese. In the fall I plan to meet with our finance council to determine whether we are better off paying off old debt, spending our emergency fund and how much new debt would be advisable.

I am willing to discuss this matter with interested parishioners. I may call on some of you to form a Buildings, Maintenance and Planning Committee. There have been changes in our neighborhood and we will need to look at long term planning and possible land acquisition. I am grateful for your support of our parish; some of your support has been generational! I am trying to be a good steward to our beautiful, but aging campus. Thank you for the confidence you have placed in me. - *Father Bill*

Week Three of Camp Cougar encourages the students to become explorers. On Tuesday, campers traveled by bus to Habitat for Humanity's Global Village & Discovery Center in Americus Ga. The excursion lends itself to focus on social studies, history and geography curriculum. During their visit, they walked through displays representing poverty housing conditions in 17 countries and through examples of Habitat's rebuilt houses in the same communities. Campers also learned about different construction methods in each country and block making skills. As a follow-up to their visit, they returned to school and made water filtration systems; a much needed commodity in impoverished areas around the world where clean water may be "walked in" from miles away.

Reflexiones para la homilía

Una mamá puede pasar noches enteras sin dormir pensando en una enfermedad o un problema de uno de sus hijos. Un padre de familia se podría angustiar por su situación de inmigración, porque le falta trabajo o porque la situación económica familiar parece deteriorarse aún más y se ve desesperada. Trabajamos mucho y hay veces en que parece que el mundo se nos echa encima. ¿Qué va a ser de nosotros? Puede que el peso de las cosas nos deprima y nos haga sentir abandonados por Dios; o puede que nos enfrentemos al mal en las muchas maneras en que aparece a nuestro alrededor: envidia, ambición, mentira, infidelidad.

En muchas películas y series vemos que, por muy malvados que sean los personajes, muy grandes las mentiras y mucho mal que hagan, al final todo se descubre y triunfa la justicia. Sabemos desde el principio que eso ocurrirá, pero queremos verlo para asegurarnos de que el mal no ganará. Parece que esperamos secretamente que lo mismo ocurra en nuestra vida; pero a veces las situaciones que enfrentamos no se resuelven inmediatamente o a nuestro gusto. Entonces nuestra fe nos dice que, al final, todo lo que está escondido se revelará y que Dios está de nuestro lado, porque somos más importantes para Él que todas las criaturas a las que cuida con tanto amor.

Esta seguridad, por supuesto, no nos quitará de repente la inquietud; pero podemos hacer un acto de fe y de amor en ese Dios Padre, que nos dice que valemos más que las aves del cielo y que las flores del campo. Podemos fiarnos de que él no nos abandonará nunca; que al final, mientras nos esforcemos por hacer las obras de Dios, que son las obras del amor, tendremos la victoria.

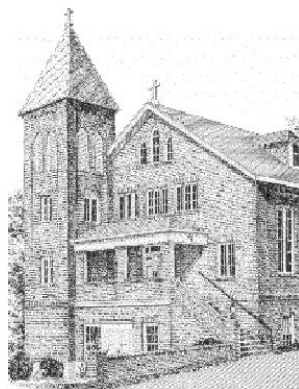
