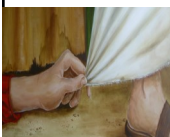

## Priestly Ordination: Deacon Drew Larkin

Deacon Drew Larkin is a native of Macon and alumni of St. Peter Claver School. He was active as an altar server in his elementary and high school years. He is a graduate of Mount de Sales Academy and the University of Georgia, where he earned a B.B.A. in Business Management. Drew worked for Wipro, an Internet Technology firm, for three years when he answered his call to the Priesthood. He finished his Pre-Theology and received a Master's degree in Philosophical Studies at Mount St. Mary's in Emmitsburg, Maryland and continued his studies in major theology at the Pontifical North American College in Rome, Italy, where he received a Bachelor of Sacred Theology in 2016. He was ordained as a transitional deacon on September 29, 2016 at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. He is currently finishing his first year of Canon Law studies in Rome. His first Mass is scheduled for Sunday, July 1<sup>st</sup> at 11:15 am, followed by a reception in the St. Katharine Drexel Center. The Priestly Ordination for Deacon Drew Larkin is Saturday, June 30th, at 10:00 am in Savannah.

# El Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo 3 de junio de 2018

Levantaré el cáliz de salvación e invocaré el nombre del Señor.  
— Salmo 116 (115):13



## Reflexiones para la Homilia

Hoy celebramos la fiesta del Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo. Recordamos el mayor regalo que nos dejó Jesús. Cuando nos reunimos en su nombre, como hermanos y hermanas, a compartir la comida, como él nos enseñó, nos convertimos en lo que comemos. El pan y el vino compartido son el Cuerpo y la Sangre del Señor. Al comerlo, nos hacemos Cuerpo de Cristo. En la antigüedad, al compartir la Eucaristía se decía: "Recibe lo que eres. Conviértete en lo que recibes".

La primera lectura de hoy habla de la primera alianza entre Dios y su pueblo. Una alianza es un contrato sagrado. Los términos de tal contrato son: el pueblo vivirá de acuerdo a los mandamientos de Dios y Dios permanecerá fiel a su pueblo. Dios nunca abandonará al pueblo en tiempo de dificultad. Se formaliza la alianza a través de un sacrificio.

Jesús ofreció a su pueblo una nueva alianza. El sacrificio no es de animales, sino del propio Jesús al dar su cuerpo y sangre en la cruz. Nuestra responsabilidad a la alianza es recordar. Debemos recordar a Jesús, recordar sus palabras y acciones, y recordar su gran sacrificio. Cuando hacemos eso, recibimos fuerza y alimento para vivir de acuerdo a su voluntad, para que tengamos vida y la tengamos en abundancia. ¿Cómo recordamos a Jesús? Lo recordamos y cumplimos nuestra parte de la alianza haciendo lo que hacemos aquí hoy. Jesús nos pidió que lo recordásemos reuniéndonos como hermanos para compartir una comida. En ella recordamos sus enseñanzas y nos comprometemos a perdonarnos unos a otros. Por supuesto, la comida que compartimos es la Eucaristía. La misa no es simplemente un ritual que venimos a observar a la iglesia el domingo solo porque es nuestra obligación. Jesús no nos pide que vengamos a oír misa. La misa es una reunión de hermanos que expresan la fe en unidad y se comprometen con Dios y unos con otros. Cuando hacemos eso, cumplimos nuestra parte de la Nueva Alianza. Jesús, a su vez, nos da su propia vida y su fuerza.

El gobernador de Georgia Nathan Deal firmó la Ley de la Cámara de Representantes #673, que requeriría que **los conductores usen tecnología a manos libres cuando usen teléfonos celulares y otros dispositivos electrónicos mientras conducen**. Pero "manos libres" no es tan claro como parece. Aquí hay una lista de lo que se permitiría y no se permitiría. **La ley entra en vigencia el 1 de julio de 2018.**



### Prohibido

- \* Sostener o soportar, con cualquier parte del cuerpo, un dispositivo inalámbrico de telecomunicaciones o un dispositivo electrónico autónomo (por ejemplo, un iPod).
- \* Escribir, enviar o leer cualquier comunicación basada en texto, incluyendo un mensaje de texto, mensaje instantáneo, correo electrónico o datos de Internet mientras sostiene su dispositivo.
- \* Ver un video o una película que no sea \relacionados con la navegación de su vehículo (por ejemplo, su aplicación de mapas o su pantalla de GPS).
- \*Grabando un video.

### Permitido

- \*Hablando o enviando mensajes de texto mientras usas tecnología de manos libres.
- \*Usar un sistema de GPS o una aplicación de mapas.
- \*Estar puesto y usar un reloj inteligente.
- \*Usar un auricular para hablar por teléfono.

\*Hay circunstancias en las que puedes manejar un dispositivo electrónico mientras conduces: Denunciar un accidente de tráfico, una emergencia médica, un incendio, un crimen o un acto delictivo o una condición peligrosa en la calle. También puede usar sus manos si está legalmente estacionado (no en un semáforo - "legalmente" significa apagado o al lado de la carretera en una área abierta para estacionarse).

## Las lecturas y su mensaje

### Génesis 3:9-15

Esta lectura trata de la continua lucha entre el bien y el mal, que es parte de la vida humana. Ante Dios, la humanidad representada por Adán y Eva es consciente de sus actos y se avergüenza; pero no es capaz de aceptar su responsabilidad. Adán culpó a Eva (e indirectamente a Dios) y Eva culpó a la serpiente. Hoy sabemos que, aun cuando las elecciones humanas nos conduzcan al mal, Dios no nos abandonará. El sacrificio de Jesús y su victoria sobre la muerte nos han asegurado que el bien nunca será superado por el mal; pero, tenemos que ser responsables de nuestras malas acciones y no repetir las.

### 2 Corintios 4:13-5:1

En este fragmento de su carta, Pablo afirma y nos recuerda que, como Jesús, nosotros también tendremos vida eterna por la gracia de Dios. El apóstol distingue entre lo que vemos (que es transitorio) y lo que no vemos (que es eterno); y llama a no temerle al proceso natural de desgaste físico del cuerpo, porque nuestro espíritu —que es nuestro verdadero ser— se renueva a diario. Consecuentemente, nos recuerda que nuestro cuerpo es la morada terrenal de nuestro espíritu; pero su morada eterna está en el cielo. Si confiamos en el Señor, lo que ocurra en nuestra vida será para nuestro provecho espiritual y para gloria de Dios.

### Marcos 3:20-35

Algunos de quienes rodeaban a Jesús no entendían su misión y pensaban que estaba loco. Solo veían que había elegido un camino, como poco, difícil, y además, peligroso. Incluso su familia debió temer que ese camino lo llevara a un enfrentamiento con las autoridades civiles romanas y religiosas judías, como finalmente ocurrió. Jesús afirma en esta lectura su libertad para elegir cumplir su misión divina y que quienes lo acepten y reconozcan su ministerio constituyen su familia y compartirán el amor de Dios. En otras palabras, al hacer la voluntad de Dios nos volvemos parte de la familia de Dios.

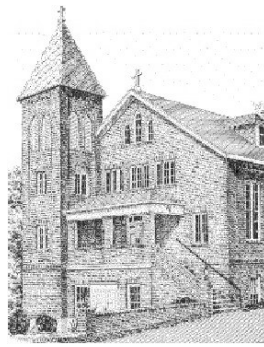
